These applications seeks impleadment and modification of order of this Tribunal dated 03.09.2019.

We have perused the order dated 03.09.2019 which is on the subject of remedial action against discharge of untreated industrial effluents, damaging the eco-system and health of the inhabitants. The Tribunal examined the matter in the light of the expert committee report showing that the CETP operator was violating the environmental norms. The Tribunal, accordingly, directed the statutory regulators to take further appropriate action in accordance

with law and furnish a compliance report. The compliance is to be considered on 04.11.2019.

In view of the above, the grievance of the applicant, if any, has to be gone into by the regulators in the first instance which order is statutorily appealable. I.A. Nos. 637/2019 & 638/2019 are, accordingly, dismissed.
